Ingalls creates employee resource hub

To meet the Dec. 8 deadline, Moderna first shot must be taken by Oct. 27 and second shot by Nov. 24. The Johnson & Johnson single shot vaccine must be taken by Nov. 24. All vaccines are considered effective after 14 days have passed from final injection date.

To comply with the Federal COVID-19 vaccination mandate, all Huntington Ingalls Industries employees, including all Ingalls Shipbuilding employees, contractors, vendors and customers, are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by **Dec. 8, 2021**.

The federal mandate applies to Ingalls and to every other shipyard doing work for the U.S. Navy and Coast Guard. In order to continue this work and to get new work, Ingalls must follow all federal regulations

as with all other contract requirements.

Ingalls wants all shipbuilders to make informed decisions regarding the vaccination mandate.
